# Threshold Housing First

## Greater Manchester, England, UK

**Project Description**: This is a specialized Housing First program that targets the unique needs of homeless women with a history of offending. The service has continued in the Greater Manchester Area after the completion of a two-year pilot program from 2015 -2017.

**Distinguishing Features**: Threshold Housing First works predominately with women who are referred by parole or other criminal justice services and require highly individualized support programs for a complex combination of needs.

#### **SUMMARY**

Threshold Housing First started as a two-year pilot program in 2015, and has since received funding for an additional three years of operations within the Greater Manchester Area. The program provides specialized services to homeless women with a history of offending and is one of the UK's predominate gender specific supported housing programs. As a result of working with this demographic, the women referred here have a complex set of support needs. A large majority of the women within the 2015-2017 pilot program had a history of mental health (91%) and addiction issues (drugs 75%, alcohol 79%), as well as experiences of domestic violence (94%). Due to the acute level of need, Threshold Housing First provides daily support for their service users, including welfare check ins every day of the week. This ongoing support is focused on building successful, trusting relationships. Their wholistic program model of service works to ensure the women feel valued, motivated, and empowered with life skills to support themselves going forward.

# **Support Services Offered**

Threshold follows the 'consumer choice' model of Housing First initiatives, so the supports offered are highly individualized based on the service users' needs. The women do not receive a standardized, package of support, because they play an ongoing, central role in determining what that support is. Threshold Housing First bases this co-produced program of support around four main areas:

# **Threshold**

Threshold is a support charity operating in multiple locations across the Greater Manchester Area in North West England. Their focus is supporting vulnerable people towards independence and wellbeing. While they provide a variety of housing services from low support to intensive housing management, their expertise is working with gender specific Housing First programs and domestic violence services. Their program is one of the largest, longest running Housing First Programs for women in the UK. Their goal is to provide quality services to vulnerable people so they can achieve their full potential and make a positive contribution to the communities where they live.
